

Minutes of the meeting of the Principals/Directors of Colleges Offering Non AICTE Courses held on 15.12.2017 in Maulana Abul Kalam Azad University of Technology, West Bengal

As desired by the hon'ble Vice Chancellor a meeting of the Principals/Directors of Colleges was convened on 15.12.2017 in the Conference Hall of Maulana Abul Kalam Azad University of Technology, West Bengal to discuss and resolve the following agenda.

Agenda:

1. Feasibility of Common Admission Tests (CET) for admission to various Non-AICTE courses in the affiliated colleges of MAKAUT, WB for the session 2018-19 and resolutions adopted thereon.
2. Holding of JEMAT and PGET for the session 2018-19.

The meeting was chaired by Prof. Sreeparna Bandyopadhyay.

Besides university officials, representatives from 72 Colleges attended the meeting.

At the very onset Registrar Dr. Prabir Kumar Das briefed about the reason behind calling the meeting. He spoke about the necessity of holding the CET for non-AICTE courses and accordingly moved a proposal for holding CET in 2018-19 besides JEMAT and PGET to you have a better response from the students.

The Colleges welcomed the proposal and urged that the same be held at least two times.

After detailed discussion on the issue it was agreed upon and resolved –

1. That the first CET will be held on 28th April 2018 and the date of the second one will be notified later on. That the entrance test will be conducted using OMR sheets.
2. That one JEMAT will be held in the second week of April 2018.
3. That the first PGET may be held after GATE in March 2018 and M. Tech Seats should be filled up through PGET followed by a centralized counseling.
4. That JEMAT-II will be held with PGET after the final Exam of MAKAUT –WB, tentatively at the end of June 2018.
5. That 50 % of the approved seats in the colleges will be filled up from the merit list published for CET/JEMAT/PGET-2018 after counseling. Colleges willing to admit students directly in relevant courses without CET/PGET, will have to pay a mandatory fee of Rs. 8000/- to the university per candidate – .this is just to enhance the importance of these entrance examinations.
6. That minimum 50% of the approved intake should be filled up through JEMAT after GD/PI and centralized counseling.
7. That the University will explore its extension centres for providing the students with additional centres for counseling.
8. That any college-specific criteria for admission are to be informed to MAKAUT-WB **before 22nd December 2017**. These criteria will be included in the brochure.

The additional admission criteria declared by the college will be binding for all the seats (i.e. admission through CET and the management quota).

9. That the University will arrange at least one centre in each of the following states – Assam, Tripura, Jharkhand, Bihar, Mizoram, Meghalaya, Chhattisgarh and Sikkim.
10. That the University will also explore the possibility of awareness programmes related to CET/JEMAT/PGET in the neighbouring countries like Nepal Bhutan and Bangladesh.
11. That the rates of the aforesaid examinations will be as follows:

12. That MAKAUT-WB will make awareness campaigns for the benefit of the students highlighting all courses, curriculum and the facilities of the Colleges/ Institutions through the newspaper advertisement (Full/Half/ Qtr page), campaign in Electronic media, organizing Educational Seminar etc. with the help of the Colleges on and from January 2018 to May 2018.
13. That Colleges have to contribute @ of Rs 10000/- per courses to the university for the promotional programmes.
14. Colleges are requested to furnish the web page with all the relevant queries for the intending candidates and send the details of Name , address , Ph No ,website , fax etc. as per the proforma given below in the excel format to the university within 22nd December 2017.University will link the web address to the university website.

15. That an organizing committee with representations from affiliated colleges is being constituted to execute CET/JEMAT/PGET.
